### MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

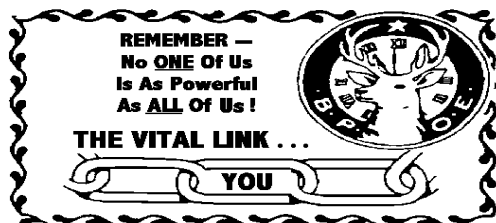
We started our Fraternal Year with 205 members on our rolls. To date, we have lost 7 members through death bringing our current membership to 198.

If you have already paid your dues, thank you. Please continue to support your lodge by attending one of our dinners, monthly breakfasts, or our A/C bus trips.



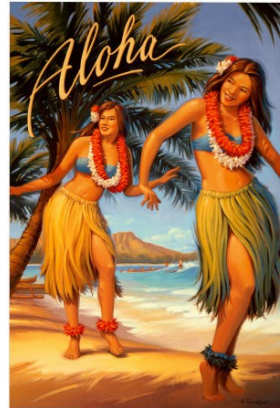
